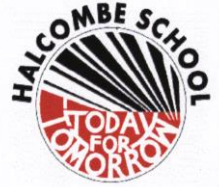

A few Level 2 reminders

- Please stay outside the gates. The pick-up system at 3pm in the carpark and on the road is working very well and we thank you for your support. We will continue to bring your child to the office area if you are late, so we can keep an eye on them. They can see cars arriving in the carpark and will come out to meet you.

- Keep reminding children to wash their hands, avoid touching their face, cough into their elbow and sanitise often.
